Mercaptopurine 50mg Tablet is used alone or in combination with other chemotherapy medicines in the treatment of Acute lymphocytic leukaemia (ALL; also known as acute lymphoblastic leukaemia and acute lymphatic leukaemia; a kind of cancer that starts in the white blood cells). Mercaptopurine belongs to the group of drugs known as purine antagonists. It functions by halting the development of cancer cells.

How Mercaptopurine Tablet Works?

Mercaptopurine prevents cancer cells' RNA and DNA from growing by replacing their structural components. It stops the growth and reproduction of cancer cells.

How to Use - Mercaptopurine 50mg Tablet

- Mercaptopurine is available as a tablet and liquid suspension for oral use. Typically, it is given once a day. It should be taken every day at about the same time(s). Ask your doctor to clarify any instructions you do not understand, and carefully follow the instructions on your prescription label.
- Mercaptopurine should be taken exactly as prescribed. Never take it in larger or fewer amounts or more frequently than directed by your doctor.
- Despite feeling good, keep taking Mercaptopurine 50mg Tablet. Discontinue taking

mercaptopurine only after consulting your healthcare expert.

Other Uses of Mercaptopurine

Mercaptopurine tablet is also used in the treatment of some other cancers, Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis, and other conditions. In Crohn's disease, the body attacks the inner layer of the digestive tract, resulting in pain, diarrhoea, weight loss, and fever.

Medical Benefits of Mercaptopurine Tablet

Blood Cancer Treatment.

Leukaemia, often known as blood cancer, is a type of cancer that affects the blood-forming tissues and impairs the body's defences against infection. The Mercaptopurine Tablet destroys cancer cells or inhibits their proliferation while also preventing the spread of cancer cells.

Precautions for Mercaptopurine

- If you have an allergy to mercaptopurine, any other drugs, or any of the inert substances in mercaptopurine tablets, let your doctor know right away.
- Inform your doctor about all prescription and over-the-counter drugs, vitamins, dietary supplements, and natural remedies you are now taking or intend to use.
- Be sure to let your doctor know if you're nursing a baby or pregnant. The foetus could be harmed by mercaptopurine. If you are taking mercaptopurine, you should not breastfeed.
- During or soon after your treatment, let your doctor or dentist know if you need to have surgery, including dental surgery.
- If you've already taken thioguanine or mercaptopurine to treat your cancer, let your doctor know. If one or both of these treatments have previously failed to effectively treat your cancer, your doctor may advise against taking mercaptopurine.
- Inform your doctor of any infections you may have as well as any liver or kidney problems you may have now or in the past.
- Avoid getting vaccines without first consulting your doctor.

Side Effects of Mercaptopurine Tablet

Mercaptopurine might have undesirable effects. If any of the following symptoms are serious or do not go away, let your doctor know right away:

- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Skin turning darker
- Hair fall
- Rash

Some adverse effects can be very harmful. Call your doctor right away if you notice any of these signs:

- Light skin
- Weakness
- Breathing difficulty
- Any indications of infection, such as a sore throat, fever, or chill.
- Legs, ankles, or foot swelling
- Significant bruising or bleeding
- Eyes or skin that has a yellow tint
- Reduced appetite
- Diarrhoea
- Bloating around the stomach
- Stomach ache in the top right corner

You should keep in mind that your doctor recommended this drug because she or he thought it would benefit you more than it would harm you. Many users of this medicine report no significant negative effects.
