Roundworms, hookworms, threadworms, whipworms, pinworms, flukes, and other parasitic illnesses are also treated with Albendazole Tablet. It includes 'Albendazole,' a tubulin polymerization inhibitor. The parasite's metabolism is disrupted, and its energy stores are depleted, resulting in immobilisation. It can destroys the helminth and cures the infection as a result.

How to Use

- It should be taken according to your doctor's instructions for dosage and duration. It can be taken with or without food, and it is best taken at a specified time.
- Albendazole should be taken as a whole with a glass of water; chewing or crushing the tablet is not recommended.
- Even if you start feeling better, don't miss any dosages and finish the entire course of

treatment. To make up for a missing dose, do not use a double dose. Simply proceed to another next dose as scheduled.

Precaution - Albendazole Tablet 400 mg

- If you are sensitive to Albendazole or any of its ingredients, do not take it. It can develop aplastic anemia, agranulocytosis, and bone marrow suppression.
- If you have or have had liver illness, or if you have had any treatment, inform your doctor.
- If you get seizures, vomiting, headaches, excessive exhaustion, or behavioral problems while consuming medication, call your doctor right away.
- During medication with Albendazole Tablet, blood cell counts and liver function should be checked on a regular basis.
- Albendazole Tablet 400 mg may raise the risk of infection; keep good hygiene and avoid contact with people who have illnesses, flu, or colds.

Side Effect for Albendazole
