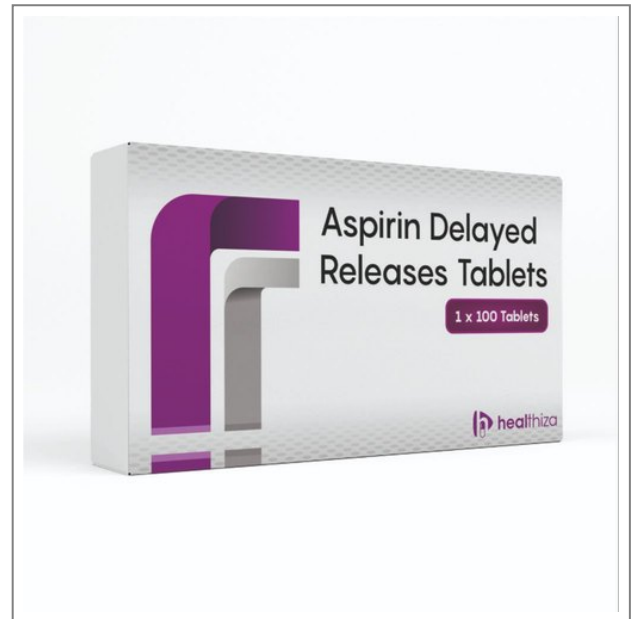

## Product Description :

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### What is Aspirin Delayed Releases Tablet 81 mg?

Aspirin Delayed Releases Tablet 81 mg is used in the treatment of headaches, irregular menstrual, arthritis, toothaches, and muscle aches, as well as to lower fever. It's used to keep people who have had a heart attack before or who have angina from having another one (chest pain occurs when the heart does not get sufficient oxygen supply). It's also used to lower the chance of death in those who are having a heart attack or have just had one. In addition, aspirin is used in the prevention of ischemic strokes (strokes caused by a blood clot blocking blood flow to the brain) and mini-strokes (strokes caused by a temporary blockage of blood flow to the brain).

### How to Use Aspirin

- To reduce the heart attack risk or stroke, aspirin is normally taken once a day. To treat a fever or pain, it is normally given each 4 to 6 hours as needed. Carefully follow the recommendations on the box or on the prescription label.
- With a full glass of water, swallow the extended-release pills whole. They should not be

broken, crushed, or chewed.

- Take the Aspirin Delayed Releases Tablet 81 mg with glass of water.
- Chewable aspirin tablets can be consumed whole, crushed, or chewed. Immediately after getting these tablets, drink a glass of water.
- Before giving aspirin to child or teenager, consult your doctor. In children and teenagers, aspirin can cause Reye's syndrome (a dangerous disorder in which fat develops on the brain, liver, and other body organs), especially if they have a virus like chicken pox or the flu.
- Aspirin is also used to reduce the risk of blood clots in patients with prosthetic heart valves or other heart problems, as well as to prevent certain pregnancy issues.

#### How it Works

Aspirin belongs to a class of drugs known as salicylates. Aspirin is an anti-platelet non-steroidal anti-inflammatory medication (NSAID). It works by inhibiting the formation of certain natural compounds that induce symptoms such as fever, discomfort, edema, and blood clots. This reduces the likelihood of a heart attack or stroke. Aspirin can also be taken alongside other medicines such as antacids, pain killers, and cough and cold medicines.

#### Precaution - Aspirin Delayed Releases Tablet 81 mg

- If you are sensitive to aspirin, other pain or fever drugs, tartrazine colour, or any other medication, consult your doctor.
- Inform your doctor about any prescription and OTC medications, vitamins, nutraceuticals, and herbal products you're using or planning to use.
- If you take aspirin on a daily basis to avoid heart attack or stroke, consult your doctor before using

for pain or fever. Give sometime between taking your usual dose of aspirin and getting a dose of ibuprofen.

- If you have or have ever had asthma, a frequently congested or runny nose, or nasal

polyps, informs your doctor. There's a chance you'll have an adverse reaction to aspirin if you have these illnesses. Your doctor may advise you to avoid using aspirin.

- If you have frequent heartburn, a stomachache, kidney, liver diseases or stomach discomfort, tell your doctor.
- If you are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or breastfeeding, notify your doctor. During pregnancy, Aspirin Delayed Releases Tablet 81 mg can be administered. Unless your doctor tells you to, do not take aspirin doses larger than 81 mg during or after 20 weeks of pregnancy.
- Tell your dentist if you're taking aspirin if you're having dental surgery.
- Consult your doctor if you should use aspirin or other pain and fever treatments, especially if you take 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day.

#### Side Effects of Aspirin

The majorities of side effects are minor and will go away as your body adapts to the medication. If they don't go away or you're worried, consult your doctor.

- It's possible that you'll have an upset stomach and heartburn. Tell your doctor right away if either of these side effects persists or worsens.
- If your doctor has prescribed Aspirin Delayed Releases Tablet 81 mg, keep in mind that your doctor has determined that the advantage to you exceeds the risk of adverse effects. The majority of people who take this medicine do not have any substantial adverse effects.
- If you experience any serious side effects, such as easy bleeding, trouble hearing, ringing in the ears, indications of kidney problems, severe or persistent nausea/vomiting, unknown tiredness, dizziness, dark urine, or yellowing eyes/skin, contact your doctor immediately.
- Get medical immediate treatment if you detect any of the following very significant side effects: black stools, chronic or severe stomach discomfort, vomit that resembles coffee grounds, speech problems, weakening on one side of the body, unexpected eyesight changes, or severe headache

### Some Tips for Taking Aspirin

- Aspirin Delayed Releases Tablet 81 mg can help you avoid a heart attack or a ischemic stroke in the future.
- It's usually well-tolerated, with little adverse effects.
- To prevent an upset stomach, take it with food.
- It has the potential of making you bleed more rapidly. When shaving, using sharp instruments, or cutting fingernails or toenails, use caution.
- If you observe bleeding in your vomit or have black / tarry stools, call your doctor.
- If you get ringing in your ears or vomiting, avoid taking aspirin and consult your doctor.
