How To Use

- Make sure you're not eating dairy products like cheese, butter, yoghurt, ice cream, milk,

or milkshakes. This medicine should be taken 4 hours before or 2 hours after it has been taken.

■ The dose is regulated as necessary to keep the proper platelet level, depending on the patient's age and the ailment Revolade is used to treat.

How It Works

Revolade Tablet is a Thrombopoietin (TPO) receptor agonist that is nonimmunosuppressive. It specifically targets the TPO receptor's transmembrane surface, which is found mainly in human bone marrow neural stem cells and megakaryocytes. It raises the cell count in your bone marrow and improves platelet production, lowering your risk of bleeding.
