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### What is Docetaxel Injection?

Docetaxel injection is used to treat some types of breast, lung, prostate, stomach, and head and neck cancers alone or in combination with other drugs. It works by preventing cancer cells from growing and spreading.

#### Docetaxel Injection - How To Use

- Docetaxel injection is a substance that a doctor or nurse administers intravenously (into a vein) in a hospital or clinic. It is normally given once every three weeks over an hour.
- To assist prevent some side effects, your doctor may likely prescribe a steroid drug such as dexamethasone for you to ingest during each dosage cycle.
- Because some Docetaxel injection formulations contain alcohol, you may have some side effects during or after your infusion for 1–2 hours. Inform your doctor right away if you develop any of the following symptoms: disorientation, stumbling, getting very tired, or feeling inebriated.

- Ovarian cancer is sometimes also treated with Docetaxel injection (cancer that begins in the female reproductive organs where eggs are formed).

#### Precautions for Docetaxel

### Before using Docetaxel Injection,

- If you have an allergy to Docetaxel injection,

, other drugs, or any of the components in docetaxel, notify your doctor.

- Tell your doctor about any additional drugs, vitamins, nutritional supplements, or herbal products you're taking or planning to use. Antifungals such as

[itraconazole](#)

,

[ketoconazole](#)

, and voriconazole; clarithromycin; HIV protease inhibitors such as

[atazanavir](#)

,

[indinavir](#)

,

[nelfinavir](#)

, ritonavir, and saquinavir; Your specialist may need to adjust your prescription dosages or keep a close eye on you for side effects.

- If you drink and have ever drunk a lot of alcohol, tell your doctor.
- If you are expect pregnancy, planning to become pregnant, or intend to father a child, notify your doctor. Consult your healthcare expert about birth control options for preventing pregnancy during this period.

- If you're breastfeeding, let your doctor know. You should not feed while taking docetaxel injection.
- Tell your doctor that you are receiving docetaxel injection if you are having surgery, including dental surgery.
- You should be aware that docetaxel injection contains alcohol, which may cause drowsiness or impair judgment, thinking, or motor skills. Do not drive or operate heavy machinery until you have a better understanding of how this drug affects you.

#### **Docetaxel Injection - Benefits**

Docetaxel Injection is a drug that is used to treat breast cancer. It can be used alone or in conjunction with other drugs or treatments such as chemotherapy. This medication will improve breast cancer symptoms such as breast lumps, bloody nipple discharge, and changes in the form or texture of the breast. It will destroy or slow the cancer cell growth while also preventing them from multiplying. If any of the adverse effects trouble you, talk to your doctor.

#### **Side Effect of Docetaxel Injection**

- The majorities of side effects are minor and will go away as your body adapts to the medication. If they don't go away or you're concerned about them, consult your doctor.
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, exhaustion, dizziness, drowsiness, constipation, and lack of appetite are all possible side effects. Nausea and vomiting can be quite unpleasant. Your doctor may recommend medicine to prevent or treat nausea and vomiting in specific circumstances.
- Hair loss and nail changes are possible side effects. After therapy, normal hair growth and nail look should resume.
- This medicine may impair your body's capacity to fight illness. If you experience any signs of infection, call your doctor straight once.
- This medicine rarely causes a severe allergic reaction. However, if you detect any symptoms of a major allergic response, such as a rash, itching/swelling, extreme dizziness, or problems breathing, seek medical treatment right away.
- Contact your doctor if you experience any other side effects not listed above.

#### **Some Tips for Using Docetaxel**

- Docetaxel Injection is an anti-cancer drug used to treat breast cancer, non-small cell lung cancer, prostate cancer, and head and neck malignancies.
- It should not be used if you are pregnant or breast - feeding. Avoid pregnancy while receiving this medicine by using a reliable method of contraception.
- During treatment with this medicine, your doctor may order regular blood tests to evaluate your blood cells and liver function.
- Swelling of the hands and lips, as well as weight gain, are possible side effects. Your doctor may prescribe corticosteroids in addition to this prescription to help with the side effects.
- If you detect unexplained bruising or bleeding, a sore throat, mouth ulcers, a high temperature (fever), or other signs of infection, contact your doctor right once.
