What is Methotrexate Tablet?

Methotrexate tablet is a drug that is used to cure severe psoriasis (a skin condition in which red, scaly patches appear on certain parts of the body). It is also used to treat severe active rheumatoid arthritis that is not managed by other drugs, physical therapy, and other medications. Methotrexate is also used to treat malignancies that start in the tissues that form around a fertilised egg in the uterus, breast cancer, lung cancer, some cancers of the head and neck, lymphoma, and leukaemia (cancer that begins in the white blood cells). It belongs to a class of drugs known as antimetabolites. Methotrexate is a cancer treatment that works by reducing the proliferation of cancer cells.

How to use Methotrexate

- Methotrexate is available as a pill that must be swallowed. The timetable is determined by your medical condition and how your body reacts to the drug.
- Your doctor may recommend taking a methotrexate tablet on a rotating schedule, in which you alternate taking the medicine for several days with not taking it for several days or weeks.

- If you're taking methotrexate for psoriasis or rheumatoid arthritis, your healthcare professional may recommend that you only take it once a week.
- If you're being treated for psoriasis or rheumatoid arthritis with methotrexate, your doctor may begin you on a low dose and gradually increase it. Pay close attention to the instructions.
- If you're taking methotrexate to treat arthritis, it could take 3 to 6 weeks for your difficulties to start to improve, and it could take 12 weeks or longer for them to completely disappear.
- Even if you feel better, keep taking the methotrexate tablet. Stopping methotrexate without consulting your doctor is not a good decision.

Methotrexate Tablet - Precautions

Before taking Methotrexate,

- If you have an allergy to methotrexate tablets or any of the substances in methotrexate, notify your doctor.
- Tell your doctor about any prescription and over-the-counter medications, vitamins, nutraceuticals, and herbal products you're using or planning to use.
- Mention any of the following medications, such as

[chloramphenicol](#)

, penicillins, and tetracyclines; folic acid; other rheumatoid arthritis medications; phenytoin; probenecid; sulfonamides such as co-trimoxazole, sulfadiazine, Your specialist may need to adjust your prescription dosages.

- While using a methotrexate tablet, you should not breastfeed.
- Tell your doctor or dentist that you are taking methotrexate if you are having surgery, including dental surgery.
- Wear protective clothing, sunglasses, and sunscreen to minimise unnecessary or prolonged exposure to sunlight or UV light. Methotrexate can make your skin more vulnerable to UV radiation and sunshine.

- Do not get any immunizations while taking a methotrexate tablet without first seeing your doctor.

Benefit of Methotrexate

In Rheumatoid Arthritis Treatment

- Methotrexate Tablet is part of a class of drugs known as antimetabolites. If previous therapies for severe rheumatoid arthritis have failed, they may be used to treat the condition. It isn't recommended as a first-line treatment. It works by lowering the immune system of the body, which reduces swelling, discomfort, and stiffness, and improves function. To obtain the best benefit, take it exactly as directed and for as long as directed.

Methotrexate Tablet - Side Effects

- The majorities of side effects are minor and will go away as your body adapts to the medication. If they don't go away or you're concerned about them, consult your doctor.
- Nausea, vomiting, stomach problems, sleepiness, and dizziness are all possible side effects. Consult your doctor right away if any of these side effects persist or worsen.
- Remember that your doctor provided this medication because he or she believes the advantage to you exceeds the risk of adverse effects. The majority of people who take this medicine do not have any substantial adverse effects.
- If you experience any serious side effects, such as mouth sores, diarrhoea, or indications of anaemia, contact your doctor straight away.
- This drug may make it more difficult for you to fight infections. This may increase your chances of getting a serious infection or worsen any infection you already have.
- This medicine rarely causes a severe allergic reaction. However, if you detect any symptoms of a major allergic response, such as a rash, itching/swelling, extreme dizziness, or problems breathing, seek medical treatment right away.
- Contact your doctor if you have any other side effects not listed above.

Some Tips for Methotrexate

- Once per week, on the same day each week, take it.
- Drink plenty of fluids while taking this medication by drinking plenty of water.
- Take folic acid only as directed by your doctor. This will help to reduce the medication's side effects.
- Methotrexate Tablet may take 6 to 8 weeks to work. Continue to take the medication as directed.
- While taking this prescription, avoid consuming alcohol since it may raise the chance of negative effects.
- It has the potential to harm an unborn child. After your final dose, wait at least 6 months before getting pregnant.
