Product Description:

What is Nevirapine Tablet?

Nevirapine Tablet is used in combination with other drugs to cure human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection in adults and children 15 days of age and older. Nevirapine belongs to a group of drugs known as non-nucleoside reverse transcriptase inhibitors (NNRTIs). It works by lowering HIV levels in the bloodstream. It can reduce your risk of acquiring AIDS and HIV-related illnesses, infections or cancer. Taking these medications, as well as practicing safer sex and following other lifestyle changes, may reduce the risk of spreading HIV to others.

Nevirapine Tablet - How To Use

- Nevirapine is available in the form of a tablet, a prolonged tablet, and a solution (liquid) that can be taken with or without meals. It typically taken once a day for the first two weeks, then twice a day after that. After at least 2 weeks of treatment with standard nevirapine tablets, the prolonged tablet is usually given once a day. Follow the advice on your medicine label carefully.
- Nevirapine tablet should be taken with liquids like water, milk, or soda.

- Completely swallow the extended-release pills. They should not be split, chewed, or crushed.
- Nevirapine tablet can help manage HIV, but it won't cure it. Even if you feel great, keep taking nevirapine. Do not stop accepting nevirapine or any of the other

HIV drugs

you are taking.

■ If you haven't taken nevirapine tablet in 7 days or longer, consult your doctor before starting it again. Your doctor will begin you on a small dose of nevirapine and gradually raise it over the course of two weeks. Your disease will become more challenging to handle if you skip doses or stop accepting nevirapine tablet.

How It Work - Nevirapine Tablet

This medicine can restricts HIV virus multiplication in human cells, preventing the infection from creating new viruses.

Nevirapine Tablet - Precautions

- If you are sensitive to nevirapine or any other medications, notify your doctor.
- Tell your doctor about all of your prescription and nonprescription drugs, vitamins, and nutritional supplements. Make a point of mentioning one or more of the following: Certain antifungals such as

<u>fluconazol</u>e

, itraconazole,

ketoconazole

- , and voriconazole; Many other medicines may react with nevirapine, so inform your doctor about all of your current prescriptions.
- Tell your doctor about any herbal supplements you're using.
- If you have or have had had kidney disease, tell your doctor, especially if you are on dialysis (treatment to clean the blood outside the body when the kidneys are not working

well).

- If you are pregnant or expect to become pregnant, notify your doctor. Call your doctor when you become pregnant while using nevirapine tablet. If you have HIV or are taking nevirapine, you should not breastfeed your baby.
- You should be aware that this medicine may cause women to lose their fertility. If you're worried about your fertility, consult a doctor about the hazards of using this drug.
- You should be aware that body fat may accumulate in various places of your body, such as your waistline, upper back, neck, breasts, and stomach. Your face, legs, and arms may experience a reduction of body fat.
- You should be aware that when taking HIV drugs, your immune system may become better and start to fight other illnesses already present in your body, or cause other problems to develop. It's possible that you'll develop symptoms of such infections or disorders as a result of this.

Nevirapine Tablet - Side Effects

- It's possible that you'll have fatigue, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhoea. Drowsiness is an unusual occurrence. Consult your doctor right away if any of these side effects persist or worsen.
- Remember that your doctor provided this medication because he or she believes the advantage to you exceeds the risk of adverse effects. The majority of people who takethis medicine do not have any substantial adverse effects.
- This reaction could take place at any time. If you have any serious symptoms, such as unexplained weight loss, severe tiredness, muscle aches/weakness that doesn't go away, headaches that don't go away, joint pain, numbness/tingling of the hands/feet/arms/legs, changes in vision, signs of infection, signs of an overactive thyroid.
- A rash is a common side effect of nevirapine tablet, however it is usually not significant. If you get a rash, seek medical help right once.
- Although a severe adverse reaction to this medicine is uncommon, seek medicalattention right once if one happens. Contact your doctor if you experience any other sideeffects not listed above.

Some Tips for Nevirapine Tablet

- For the treatment of HIV, you've been administered Nevirapine Tablet.
- Follow your doctor's instructions for dosage and duration.
- Consult your doctor if you skip a dose for more than 7 days, as dose modification may be necessary.
- During the first two weeks of treatment, you may experience skin responses. If you observe a fever, swelling of the face, oral sores, blistering of the skin, or difficulty breathing, call your doctor.
- For an 18-week period, your doctor may monitor your liver function. If you observe yellowing of the eyes or skin, dark urine, or stomach pain, call your doctor.
- In nature, it reduces the effectiveness of birth control pills. Consult your doctor about other options for preventing pregnancy.

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
