# **Product Description:**

#### What is Mometasone Furoate Cream?

Mometasone Furoate Cream is used to treat the redness, swelling, itching, inflammation, and pain associated with a variety of skin disorders, including psoriasis (a skin disease characterized by red, scaly patches that appear on certain parts of the body) and eczema (a skin condition that triggered the skin to be dry and itchy and produced red, scaly rashes). Mometasone belongs to the corticosteroid class of drugs. It reduces swelling, redness, and itching by stimulating natural chemicals in the skin.

#### **How To Use**

- Mometasone is available as a cream, ointment, or lotion for application to the skin. It is normally used once a day. Every day, around the same time, apply it. Carefully follow the advice on your medication label.
- If your doctor tells you to, don't apply it to other parts of your body or use it in the treatment of other skin disorders.

- During the first two weeks of treatment, your skin disease should improve. If your conditions do not improve during this period, contact your doctor.
- Use a tiny amount of Mometasone Furoate Cream to the afflicted region of the skin and cover it with a thin layer.
- Apply a few drops of the lotion to the affected regions and gently massage until it disappears.
- This drug should only be applied to the skin. Avoid getting mometasone in your eyes or mouth, and avoid swallowing it.

#### **Precautions for Mometasone Furoate Cream**

- If you have allergies to mometasone or any other drugs, or any of the substances in mometasone solutions, inform your doctor immediately.
- Tell your doctor about any prescription and OTC drugs, vitamins, and nutraceuticals you're taking or planning to take.
- If you have an illness or have ever had diabetes or Cushing's syndrome, tell your doctor (an unusual condition that is produced by excess hormones).
- If you have a pregnancy, planning to become pregnant, or breastfeeding, notify your doctor.

#### **How Mometasone Works**

Mometasone Furoate Cream contains steroid that works by inhibiting the synthesis of chemical messengers that induce irritation (redness and swelling) and allergens in the body.

#### **Side Effects - Mometasone Furoate Cream**

The majorities of side effects are minor and will go away as your body adapts to the medication. If they don't go away or you're concerned about them, see your doctor.

When you use this medication, you may experience burning, itching, or stinging, although this normally only lasts a few minutes. Tell your doctor immediately if any of these side effects continue or worsen.

- Remember that your doctor provided this medication because he or she believes the advantage to you exceeds the risk of adverse effects. The majority of people who take this medicine do not have any substantial adverse effects.
- If any of the following unlikely but dangerous adverse effects occur: stretch marks, skin thinning, acne, or hair bumps, contact your doctor immediately.
- It's possible that this drug will be absorbed into the bloodstream through the skin on rare occasions. Children and people using this drug for a long period of time or across a big region of skin are more prone to experience these negative effects.

#### Some Tips for Using Mometasone Cream

- Mometasone Furoate Cream contains steroid that is used to relieve redness, swelling, itching, and irritation.
- It should be applied as a thin layer to the areas affected 2 to 3 times daily.
- Do not use it too frequently or for more than your doctor recommends.
- Unless recommended by a doctor, do not wrap the area getting treated with airtight coverings such as bandages, as this may improve the chances of side effects.
- If you suspect the region of skin you're treating has become infected, stop using Mometasone and seek medical advice.
- If your skin disease has not resolved after 2 weeks, contact your doctor.
