Product Description :

What is Rosuvastatin 40mg Tablet?

Rosuvastatin 40mg Tablet is used in combination with diet, weight loss, and exercise to lower the risk of heart attack and stroke, as well as the likelihood of heart surgery in persons with heart disease. It is also used to lower cholesterol levels in the blood, particularly low-density lipoprotein (LDL) cholesterol ('bad cholesterol) and triglycerides while increasing high-density lipoprotein (HDL) cholesterol ('good cholesterol').

How to Use Rosuvastatin

- Your doctor would most likely start you on a smaller dosage of rosuvastatin and progressively raise it once every two to four weeks.
- Even though you feel fine, keep taking Rosuvastatin 40mg Tablet. Avoid taking rosuvastatin without consulting your doctor.

Precaution - Rosuvastatin 40mg Tablet

If you have allergies to rosuvastatin, any other drugs, or any of the substances in

rosuvastatin tablets or capsules, inform your doctor immediately.

- Tell your doctor about any prescription and nonprescription medications, vitamins, nutraceuticals, and herbal products you're using or planning to use. Your doctor will need to adjust your prescription dosages or keep a close eye on you for adverse effects.
- If you're taking aluminium or magnesium hydroxide antacids, wait at least 2 hours after taking rosuvastatin before taking them.
- If you have liver disease, tell your doctor. Your doctor will arrange tests to determine how well your liver is functioning. If you have liver problems, your doctor will likely advise you not to use Rosuvastatin 40mg Tablet.
- If you're 65 or older, have or have ever had seizures, muscle pains or weakness, low blood pressure, or kidney or thyroid disorders, notify your doctor.
- If you have a pregnancy or plan to become pregnant, notify your doctor. While using rosuvastatin, you should avoid getting pregnant. Consult your doctor about birth control options while undergoing treatment.
- While using the rosuvastatin tablet, do not breastfeed.
- Tell your doctor or dentist that you are receiving rosuvastatin tablets when you are having surgery, including dental surgery. If you are admitted to the hospital for a major accident or infection, notify the doctor that you are receiving rosuvastatin.
- Consult your doctor regarding the safe consumption of alcoholic beverages while on rosuvastatin. Alcohol can make you more vulnerable to major adverse effects.

How it Works

Rosuvastatin 40mg Tablet belongs to the HMG-CoA reductase inhibitors class of drugs (statins). It is a cholesterol-lowering drug. It works by decreasing the amount of cholesterol that builds up on the walls of arteries and blocks the blood supply to the heart, brain, and other organs of the body by inhibiting cholesterol formation in the body.

Side Effects - Rosuvastatin Tablet

The majorities of side effects are minor and will go away as your body adapts to the medication. If they don't go away or you're worried about them, see your doctor.

- Remember that your doctor recommended Rosuvastatin 40mg Tablet because he or she believes the advantage to you exceeds the risk of adverse effects. Many persons who use this medicine have no major adverse effects.
- A small percentage of patients receiving rosuvastatin may have moderate memory loss or confusion. Consult your doctor if any of these uncommon side effects develop.
- Statins can occasionally induce or aggravate diabetes. Consult your doctor about the advantages and disadvantages.
- This medication may cause muscular difficulties in certain people. If you experience any of these problems during treatment or after your doctor has stopped giving you this prescription, call your doctor immediately: Signs of kidney disorders include muscle pain/tenderness/weakness (particularly when accompanied by a fever or excessive weariness).
- Rarely, this medicine can cause liver problems. If you detect any of the following rare but significant side effects: yellowing of eyes or skin, dark urine, serious stomach pain, or persistent vomiting, contact your doctor immediately.

Some Tips for Using Rosuvastatin

- It lowers "bad" cholesterol (LDL) and triglycerides to treat high cholesterol (fats). It should be used in conjunction with a low-fat diet and frequent exercise.
- Rosuvastatin 40mg Tablet is generally considered to be safe. It may induce diarrhoea, flatulence, or stomach discomfort. If any of these things happen to you, eat something.
- If you have fatigue, muscle weakness, or muscle pain, tell your doctor.
- Your doctor may perform a liver function test before you begin therapy and on a regular basis thereafter. If you see any indicators of liver disease, contact your doctor.
- Before beginning therapy with this medicine, tell your doctor if you have renal disease, liver disease, or diabetes. If you have diabetes, keep track of your blood sugar levels because Rosuvastatin can raise your blood sugar.
- If you have a pregnancy, planning a pregnancy, or are breastfeeding, avoid using Rosuvastatin.
